JANUARY NEWSLETTER FROM LAKE AVIEMORE

Well this time Barbara and I have made some big changes to the world over our wine and nibbles by the lake. We have decided to completely change the way our certificate classes are structured as we feel that some of the exercises were becoming old and tired (just like us!) We have decided to introduce several modules which are listed below in order for handlers to concentrate on one or two exercises at a time by giving their dog training on specific problems or areas they enjoy.

THESE MODULES ARE AVAILABLE TO ANY PERSON TRAINING WITH TEVRA REGARDLESS OF OTHER TRAINING YOU ARE DOING.

Each module will run for 6 weeks (may not always be consecutive weeks) and at the end of this time you will receive a certificate to say that you have completed that particular module.

The cost of the modules will remain at \$12.50 per session but this will be reduced to \$60.00 if you pay in advance for the 6 weeks. Where possible it is important for you to attend all six sessions in order to keep continuity of training but if you are unable to attend a session we will endeavour to make this up.

For those of you who are ready for an assessment in the certificate classes you have been working in these will still go ahead on 28th January. These modules are designed for all levels regardless of the certificate level you have been working at even for those of you who have completed your Advanced class.

TRAINING MODULES

1 FUN EXERCISES: (Barbara Broadhurst)

Tricks to suit all dogs
Retrieving newspaper
Sendaways to food bowl and return
Fun crate games

2 FLYBALL: (Colin Broadhurst)

Using ball, toy or food over jumps adjusted to suit the ability of your dog
Basic fly agility using obstacles

3 FOCUS: (Janice Kirk)

Teach your dog to watch you in all situations.
Suitable for dogs who are easily distracted by other dogs, people or situations in general
Teach your dog to remain on its' mat regardless of distractions.

4 EMERGENCY DROP / LOOSE LEAD WALKING (Alastair Kirk)

Teach your dog to drop instantly on command in all situations and remain until instructed otherwise.
Teach your dog to walk nicely on the lead and to obey the "get in" command.

5 PAWSITIVE RECALL: (Gail Hamling)

Teach your dog the recall with combination exercises, distractions and over jumps at increasing distances.
Retrieve over jumps.
Sendaway over jumps, round a cone and back over jumps.
Teach your dog to touch a distant point and return over jumps.
(Allowances will be made for those dogs who are unable to jump.)

Working as team, you and your dog find your way round increasingly intricate courses carrying out exercises on the way..
